have few а Zoom based events that we are going to be posting soon, we expect to see a number of these for the remainder of the vear as а




transition back to actual live events.

Retired costumes -- If you have costumes that you don't own anymore (i.e. sold, given away) please advise us so we can retire said costumes from your Legion profile.

Weapons and Accessories – While optional accessories are not necessary for basic approval, we are enjoined by the legion to make sure our weapons and/or accessories are within CRL requirements. If you added any optional accessories after your basic approval and are looking to use them during troops, please send me an email with photos of said weapon or accessory to make sure they are within Legion regulations. Costume upgrade - Similar to adding an accessory post costume approval, if you have made any upgrade to your costume, please advise your GML via an email. Inaccurate profile entries – In case you have details in your Legion profile that are not accurate (ie wrong character variant listed), send me an email so it can be addressed properly. Missing profile photos -- We don't like missing photos in our official profile. If you don't see your photos, please advise me (cont. page 3) or drop our GWL team via GWL@501stGGG.com.


